34th Annual ACRS Walk for Rice · Saturday, June 29 at 9am

The ACRS will host the Walk for Rice on Saturday, June 29, 2024, at Seward Park starting at 9am. Blaine Memorial has a very special connection to the ACRS Walk for Rice. In 1990, Herb and Bertha Tsuchiya, along with Blaine's own Sam Mitsui, initiated a way for everyone to contribute to feeding the community. Although Sam passed away in 2019, Team Blaine walks to honor his memory and his significant role in starting the Walk for Rice 34 years ago. ACRS will host the Walk for Rice on Saturday, June 29, 2024, at Seward Park starting at 9:00 AM. Last year, Team Blaine raised close to \$12,000, securing second place! This year, our fundraising goal is \$8,000.
